PRG's commitment to environmental protection is an inherent part of its sustainability programme and will be upheld throughout all decision making processes.

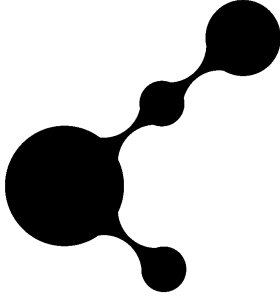
Principles:
